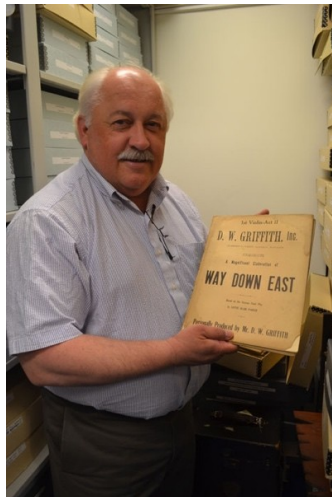

**This program will feature David Weiss, a Blue Hill resident and longtime head of the largest moving image archive in Maine/New England. David will show examples from feature films, news, promotional and family footage of modern maritime history along the Maine coast, with some examples from the Blue Hill area.**
